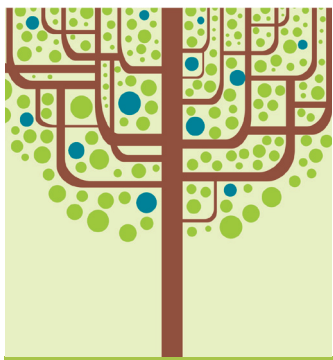

Urban and Roadside Tree Planting



Trees should be planted 12 feet from the roadway and 40 feet from each other. Trees should not be planted within 40 feet of an intersection, on the “inside” of a road curve, or in other places where a full-grown, adult tree would obstruct a driver’s view.
